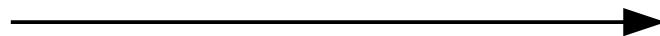

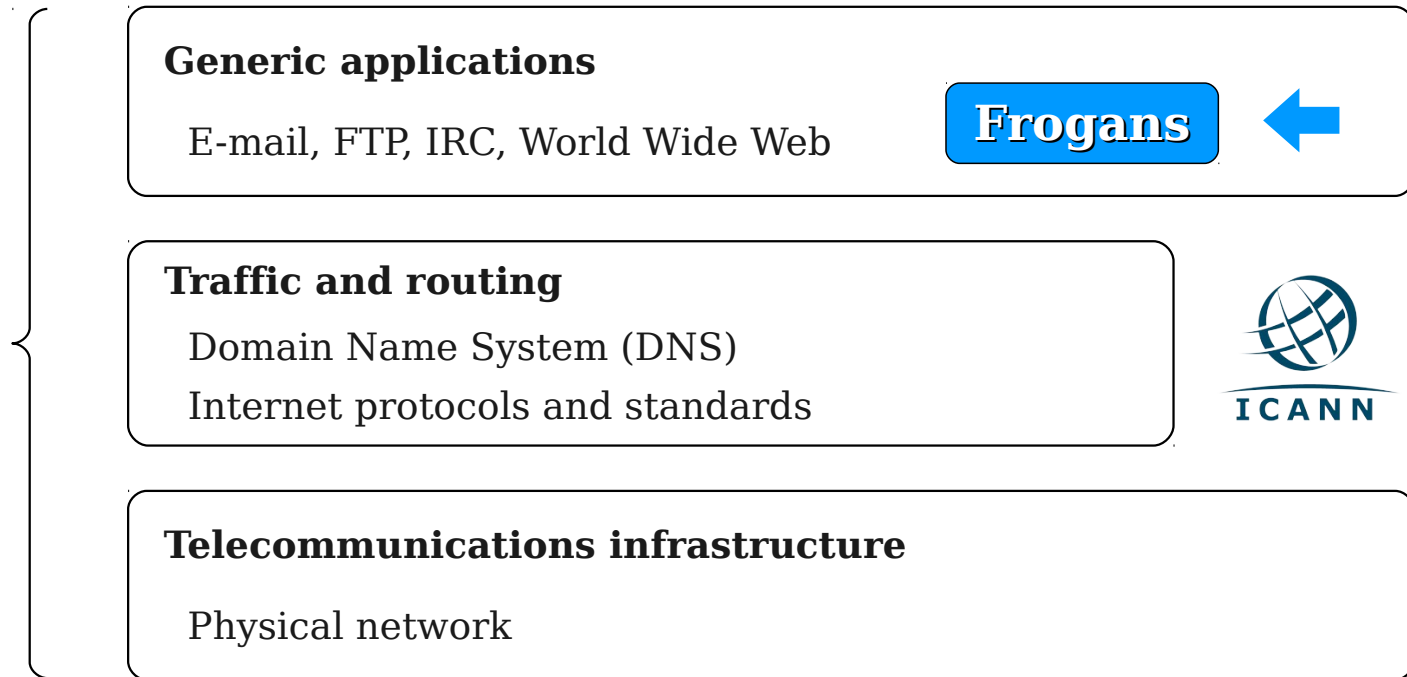
## Frogans technology

Released in the form  
of an open standard,  
available to all users,  
free of charge

- A non-profit organization established in Paris, France
- Develops the Frogans technology in the public interest
- Responsible for policy development

# Frogans technology: A new software layer on the Internet

## The three operating layers of the Internet



- A new step in the development of the Internet
- Allows the introduction of Frogans sites
- Uses the .frogans gTLD delegated by ICANN in order to function

# Frogans sites: A new format for publishing content online



- Secure
- Smaller in size and weight
- Open to the creativity of publishers all around the world

# Frogans Player: A new browser for Frogans sites



- Same browsing experience and identical display on all devices
- Downloadable free of charge from the OP3FT
- Respectful of end-user privacy

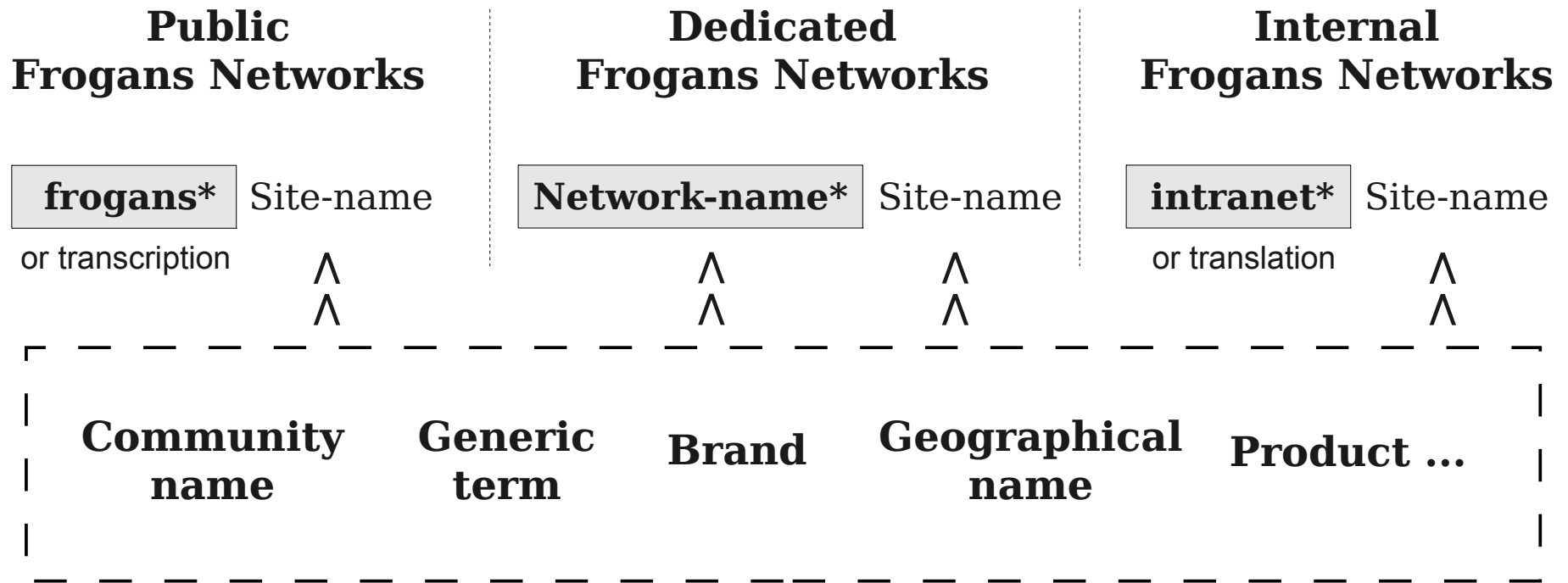

- Supports writing systems from all around the world
- Easily distinguishable thanks to the Asterisk character

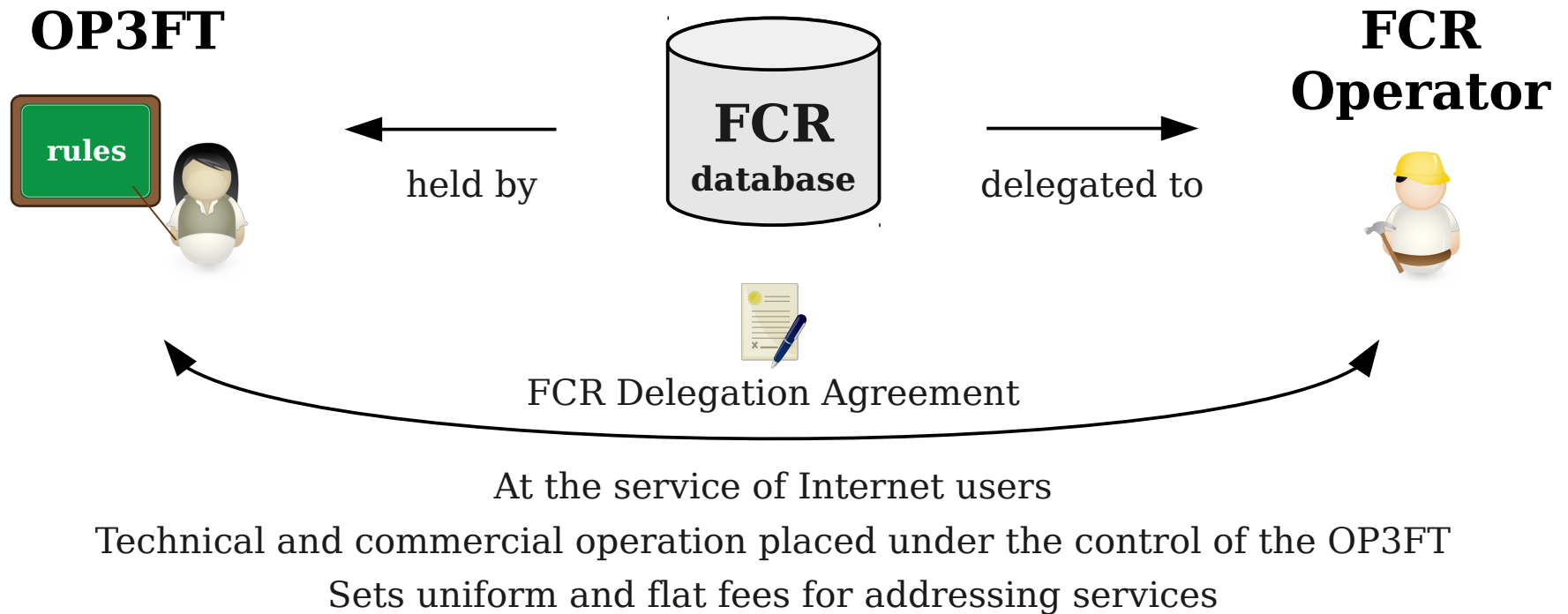
# Frogans networks: Sets of Frogans addresses



- Three types of Frogans network: public, dedicated and internal
- Customizable network names on dedicated Frogans networks
- Publication of Frogans sites on intranets using internal Frogans networks

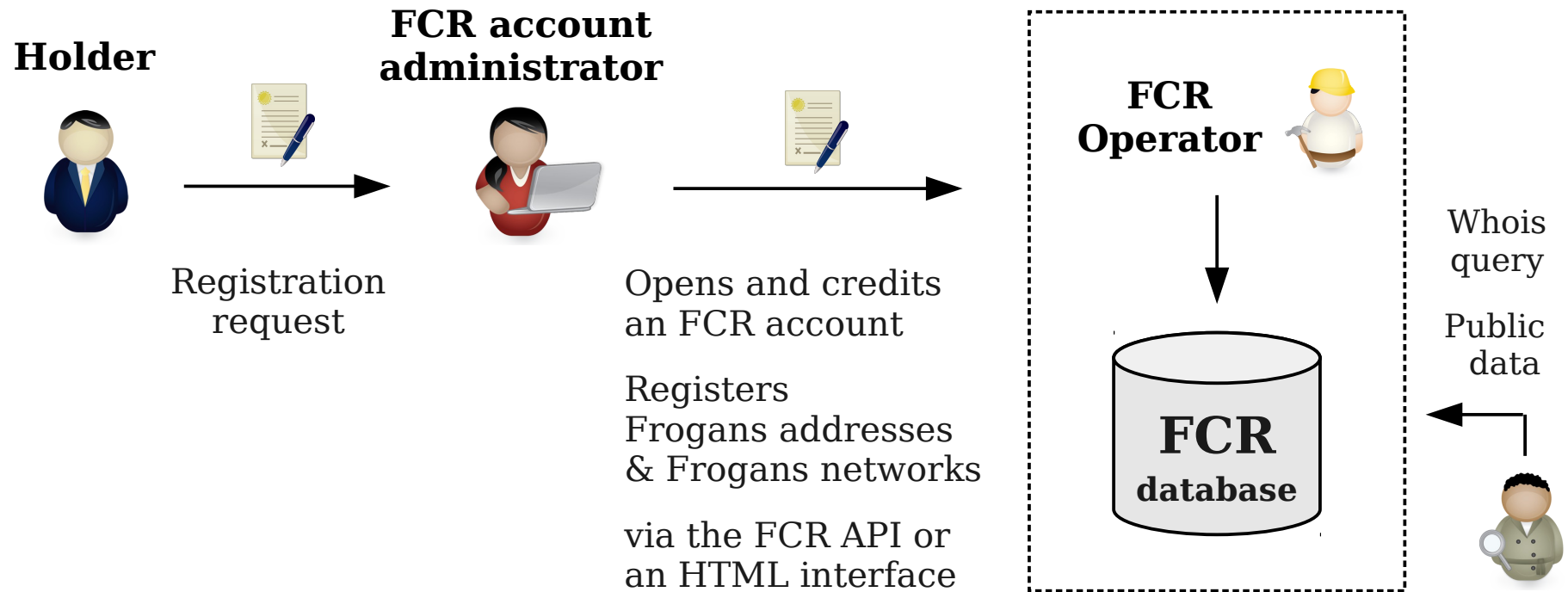


# Frogans Core Registry (FCR): a centralized database



- Contains all registered Frogans addresses and Frogans networks
- Operated by a commercial entity under a delegation contract with the OP3FT
- Database belongs to the OP3FT

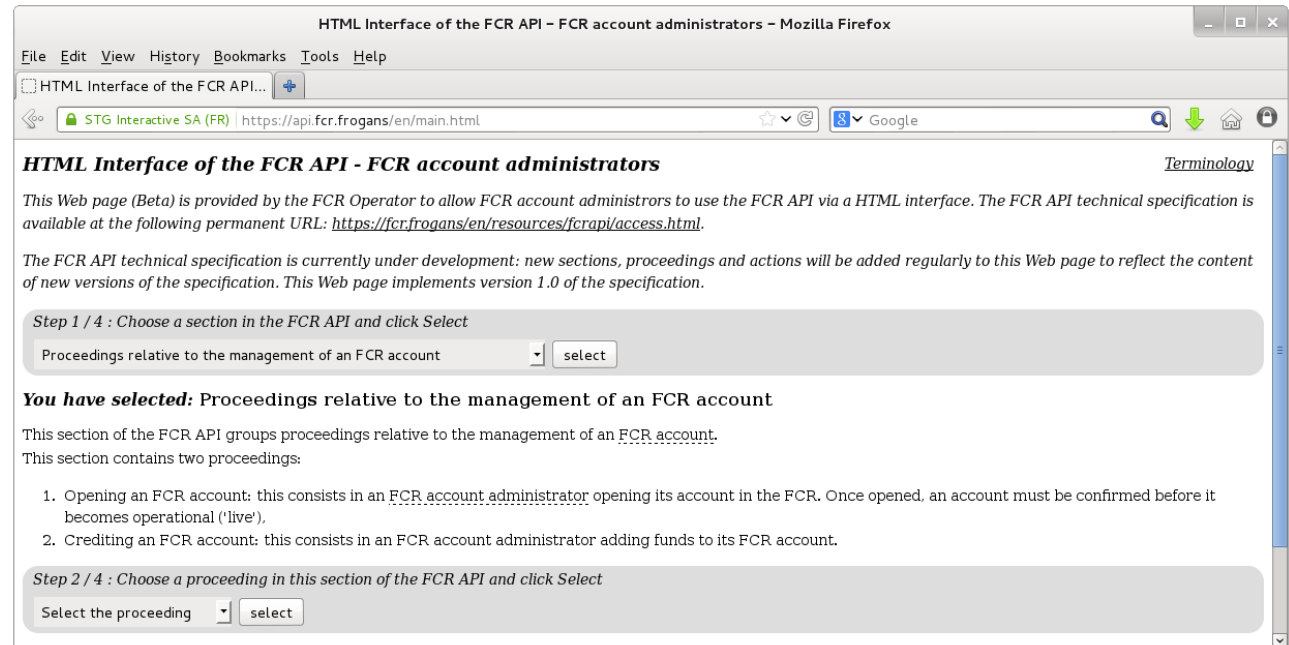
# Registration of Frogans networks and Frogans addresses



- Holders register through FCR account administrators
- No accreditation required to become an FCR account administrator
- Registrations are made on basis of "first-come, first-served" principle

# Priority registration period aimed at trademark holders

**IP firms, legal  
counsels and  
trademark holders  
can become  
FCR account  
administrators**



- Open to all trademark holders around the world (all writing systems)
- Registrations for network names only (dedicated Frogans networks)
- No additional registration costs during the priority period

- Same proceedings as UDRP
- ICANN-accredited UDRP providers are eligible

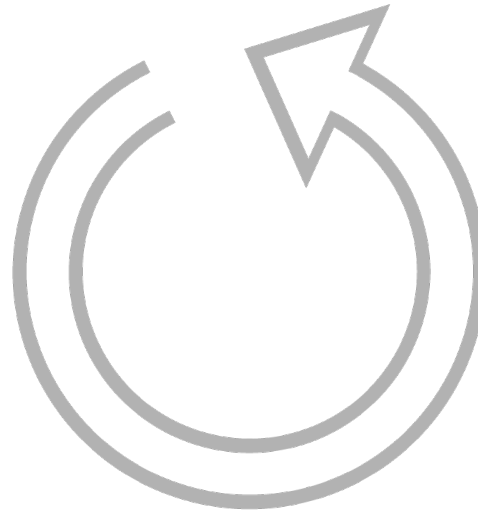

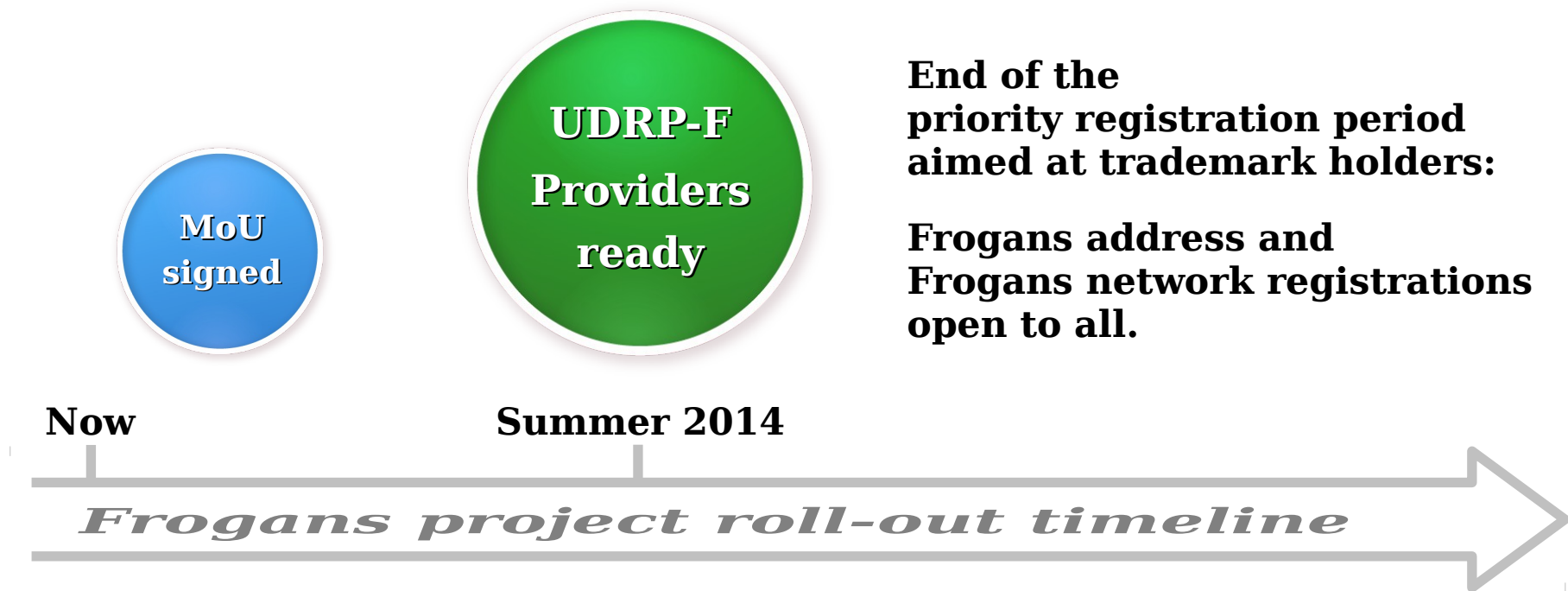

- Available remedies: cancellation or transfer of the registration
- Decisions implemented by the FCR Operator

# UDRP-F implementation



- UDRP-F proceedings to be offered from summer 2014
- Volume of disputes expected to be in same proportion as for domain names
- Implementation support available from the OP3FT (if required)
